FAQs on Latex

What is a latex paper? In Spinnaker Coating's latex facestocks, the paper fibers have been saturated or impregnated with a latex coating. This coating protects the paper from moisture, much like a latex paint would protect a wooden window sill; it does not allow the moisture to get to the wood fibers, or in this case, paper fibers.

Where would you use a latex sheet? Why not just use a film product? Latex papers should be tested where high heat and/or moisture are present. Unlike a polypropylene, the latex paper will not shrink at a higher temperature, which is helpful for applications using a laser printer. Both laser vinyl and laser polyester films tend to be more expensive than latex papers, and in short-term durability applications, the latex sheet works well in resisting moisture and/or heat. Our Laser Latex is also more flexible than the polyester film, so in some applications, such as on a curved surface, the Laser Latex may be a better option. Another general application would be for short-term bumper stickers.

Can I use a latex paper in a pharmaceutical application when it must be latex free? Yes. Normally, when someone is asking that a product be latex free, they are referring to the requirements of 21 CFR Part 801 for natural rubber content. This regulation was adopted due to the fact that many people have allergic reactions to natural rubber latex. This regulation requires all medical devices and packaging to contain no natural rubber latex. Spinnaker's latex papers are made with synthetic latex, and do not contain natural rubber latex, allowing compliance with this regulation.

So, which product should I use for my application? In general, you would use our 60# Duraform Latex for prime label applications where you still want the feel and look of a paper with added moisture resistance. While not quite as glossy as a standard Semi Gloss, it would work in most prime label applications. For thermal transfer, dot matrix print, or ball point pen applications, we would recommend you test our matte coated 62# Smudge Latex, which is offered Trimless from Troy. For laser applications, try our Laser Latex product for your end-user's variable print needs.

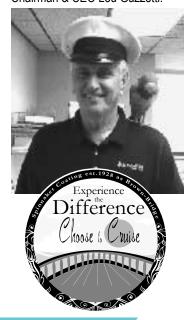
